Item 1 Organizational matters

Item 2 Financial, budgetary and administrative matters

The report on the annual review of the financial situation 2002 provides a comprehensive financial analysis of UNDP activities at the global and aggregate levels. The overview also assesses the organization's performance against the various sources available for programming.

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the above report and adopt a decision the elements of which are contained in the report.

The Executive Board will also have before it, in accordance with Governing Council decision 81/34, a report examining regular and extrabudgetary expenditure financed from sources other than UNDP, UNFPA, UNICEF and WFP, contributions received to finance these activities, as well as expenditures/contributions data reported by UNDP, UNFPA, UNICEF and WFP.

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the above report.

The report on biennial budget estimates 2004-2005 contains UNDP budget proposals and related estimates for the biennium 2004-2005 for UNDP, UNCDF and

UNIFEM. It forms part of, and underpins, the multi-year funding framework, 2004-2007.

The proposals align resources behind a strategy to consolidate and deepen reforms that have taken place in UNDP under the Administrator's Business Plans, 2000-2003. With the overarching objective of improving the performance of the United Nations development system and UNDP at the country level, the proposals reflect the strengthening role of UNDP in the United Nations system in line with the reform agenda of the Secretary-General, building knowledge and learning, and in enhancing efficiency, performance and results-orientation. Furthermore, the proposals also reflect efforts by UNDP to support programme countries in their quest to achieve the Millennium Development Goals.

The Executive Board may wish to approve the biennial budget estimates for 2004-2005 and adopt decisions, the elements of which are contained in the document.

Item 3 Thematic trust funds

The report provides a summary of the thematic trust funds mechanism, programme orientation, and initial results achieved during the first year of implementation, with highlights of key lessons learned, main challenges, and the way forward. At the request of the Executive Board, an introductory presentation on the thematic trust funds was made to members of the Board at an informal meeting on 12 June; this report reflects some comments received during that session.

Item 4

Multi-year funding framework

The multi-year funding framework (MYFF), 2004-2007, proposes UNDP priorities for the next four years. It introduces the conceptual foundations of the new framework, which feature the Millennium Development Goals. The document will outline the core goals of the organization and elaborate on a coherent set of organizational strategies. These strategies will detail how UNDP will contribute to development effectiveness, build organizational capacities and deepen partnerships with the United Nations system. The MYFF will then introduce the UNDP strategic results framework for 2004-2007, comprising a set of key service lines finalized through a rigorous process of selection. Finally, the MYFF will present the integrated resources framework, bringing together all donor and local funding sources covering programme, programme support, management and administration, and support to the operational activities of the United Nations.

Item 5

Evaluation

This year's annual report of the Administrator on evaluation, covering the period between July 2002 to June 2003, examines the progress made by UNDP in deepening the culture of performance and promoting more dynamic interaction between country operations and the evaluation function. The report looks at results in development and organizational performance, with particular focus on the link between evaluations, substantive learning, decision-making and partnerships.

The executive summary of the report on the assessment of the MDG reports introduces the key findings in preparation for a presentation of the full report and discussion at the first regular session 2004.

The Board will also have before it a report on the management response to the evaluation of the role of UNDP in the PRSP process, which was presented to the Board at the annual session 2003. The response covers the issues of linking PRSPs to MDGs, growth to poverty reduction, and democratic governance to poverty reduction and makes specific recommendations on enhancing the substantial and substantive role of UNDP in the PRSP process.

Item 6

Country programmes and related matters
