Current ABBEF Projects:

- Young People Programme: this programme is comprised of 4 projects of youth friendly centres that offer advice and information services on maternal and sexual health, family planning and STI/HIV/AIDS for young people 10 – 24 years old in Ouagadougou, Bobo - Dioulasso, Koudougou and Koupéla. A research/action based project also offers RH services to young people in the rural area of Yatenga (Ouahigouga, northern Burkina).
- Clinical Services Programme: this programme integrates clinical services into the youth friendly centres. Clinical services include: family planning, fertility problems, gynaecological, pre and postnatal consultations and management of STI and opportunistic diseases of HIV. The centre in Ouagadougou is also able to offer certain laboratory tests.
- IEC Programme: IEC activities cross cut other programmes and projects. Sensitisation activities regarding RH issues are carried out in the various geographical areas where the centres are found. The centre in Bobo-Dioulasso also supports a nursery school and assistance to volunteer representatives.

- Integrated RH Project: this project intervenes in the 4 regions crosses through the sensitisations activities. Activities include: directed group discussions, film/video projections followed by debates and discussion, home visits, individual counselling sessions, referrals as necessary.
- Integrated RH Services and Community Development Project: this project takes place in the Koudougou Region. In addition to RH activities, services for malnourished children and scholastic support to young girls in difficult situations are offered.
- Community Based Service Project: IEC and BCC activities based on peer educators (< 24 years old) who are simultaneously involved in incomes-generating micro-projects.
