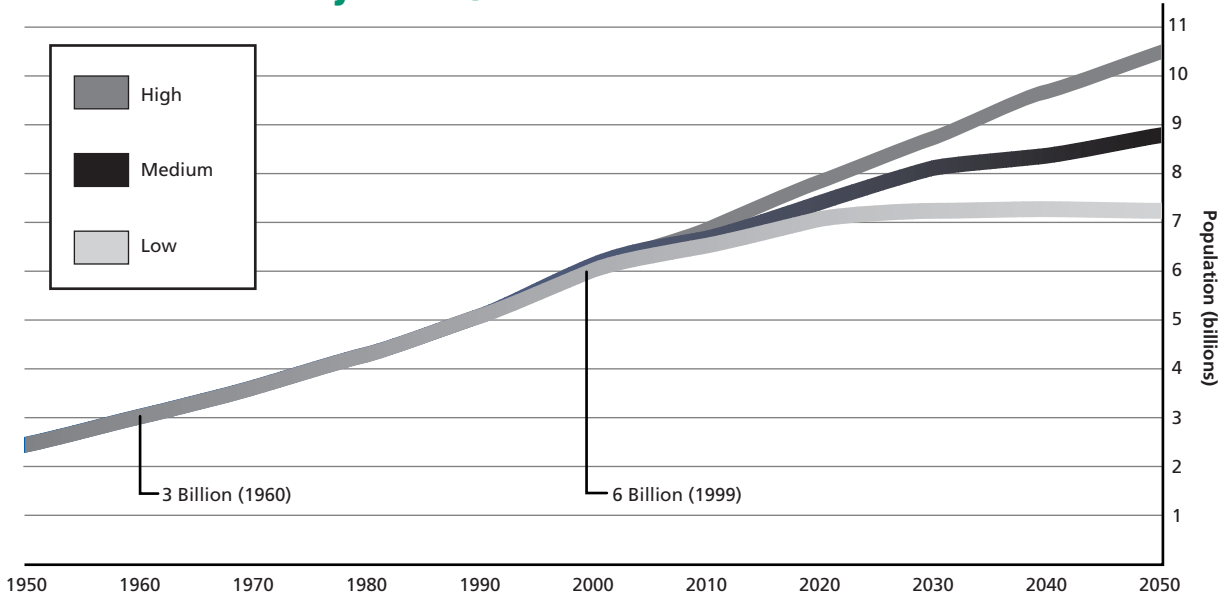

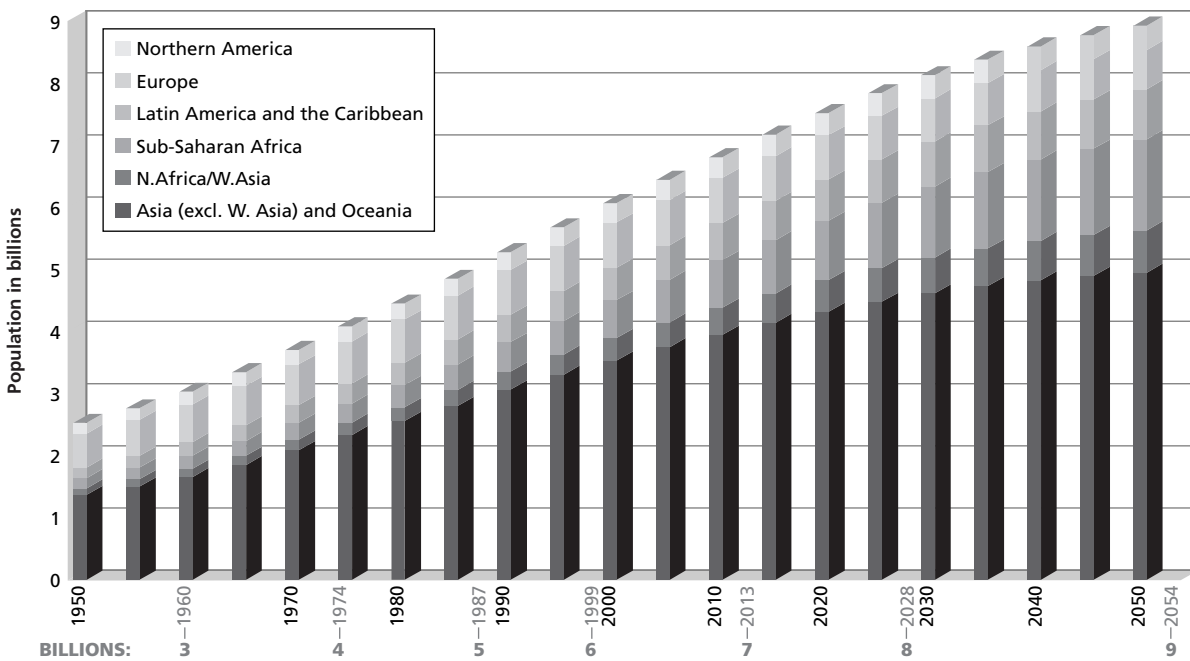

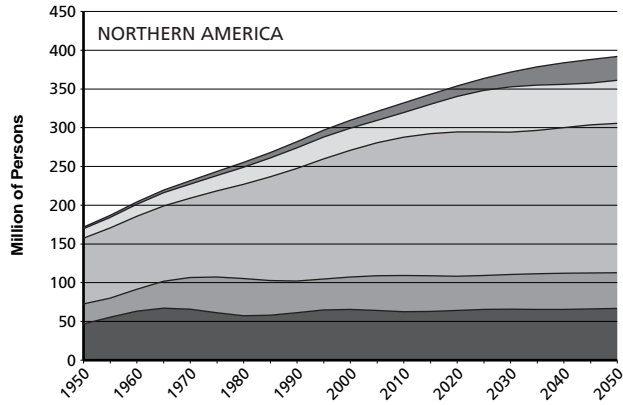

■ Age 0-14 ■ Age 15-24 ■ Age 25-64 ■ Age 65-79 ■ Age 80+

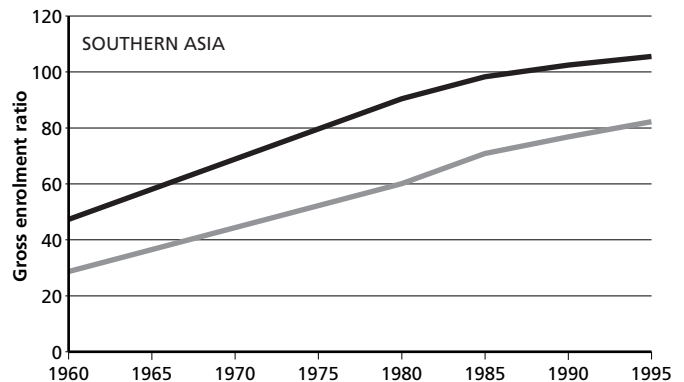
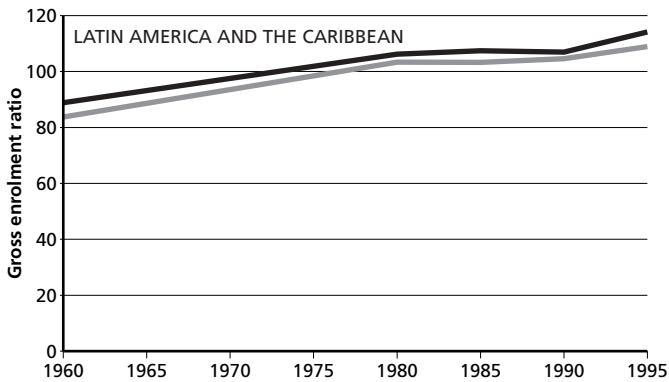
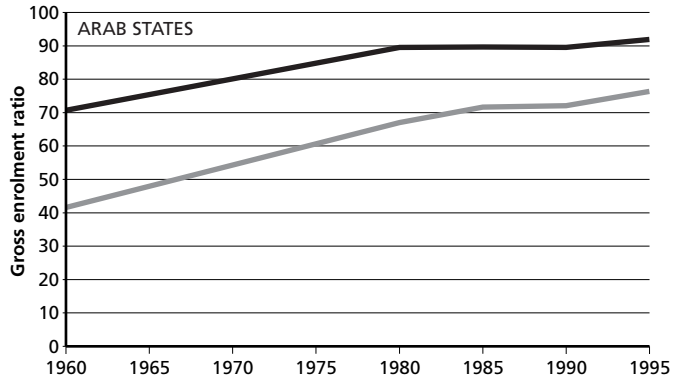
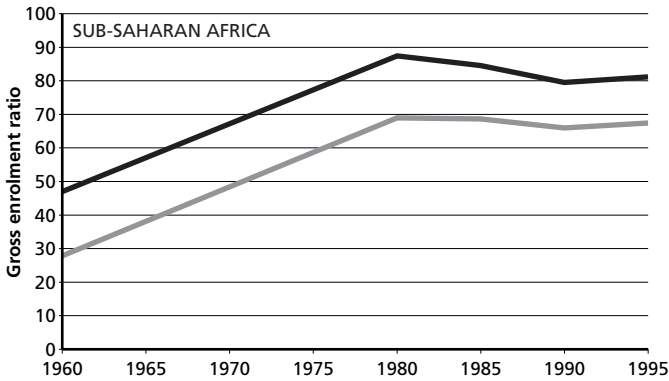

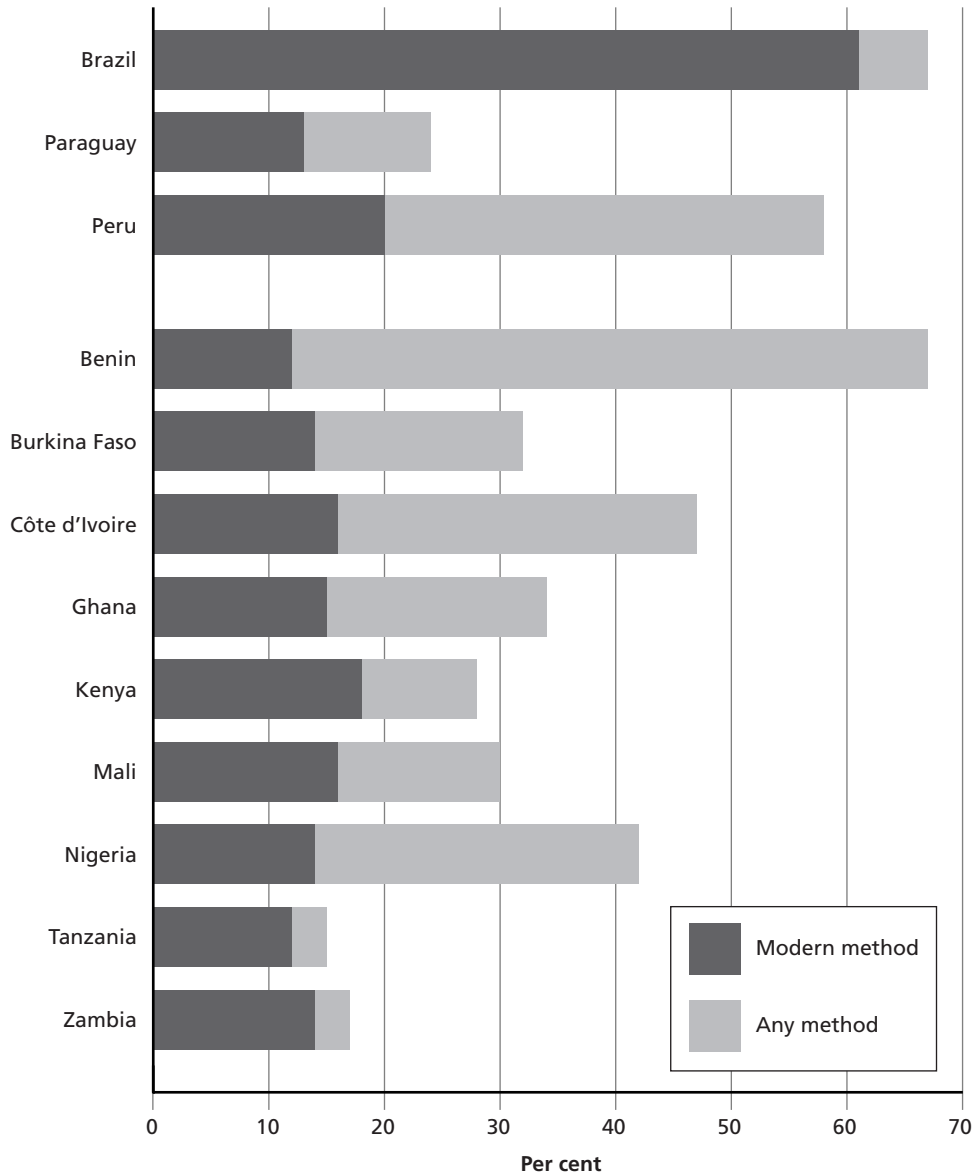
