### Analysis on population dynamics

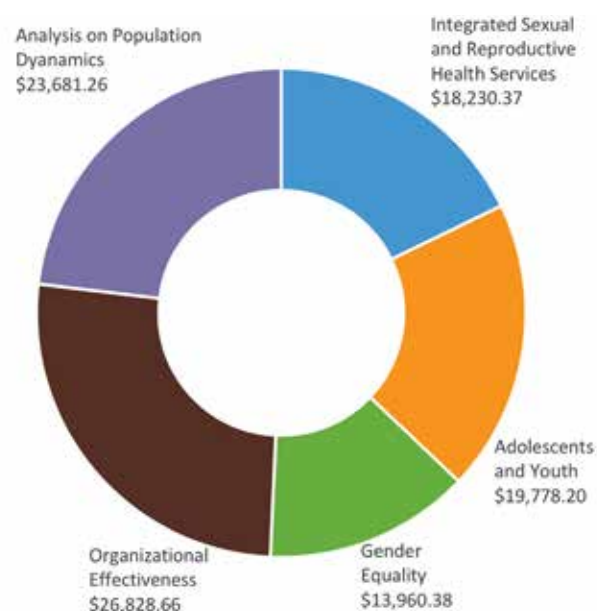
\$23,681 (23.1%)
