

### Follow-up of management responses

The table below presents the implementation rates of accepted programme evaluation recommendations for which follow-up actions are due in the year for the period 2012-2014.

Implementation rates refer to the number of accepted evaluation recommendation actions due in the year (or previous years) that have been completed in the year, divided by the total recommendation actions (those due in the year plus those outstanding from previous years)

In 2014, the Programme Division further refined the methodology to take into account the completed recommended actions pending from previous years. This, in turn, led to a necessary adjustment of the originally established baseline (90 per cent in 2012) and targets (93 per cent for 2013-2015; 97 per cent for 2016-2017). The baseline was revised to 72 per cent, and the newly established targets are now set at: 72 per cent (2013), 75 per cent (2014- 2015), and 80 per cent (2016-2017).
