The world is experiencing constant interconnected crises. International development stakeholders, including UNFPA and partners, increasingly work in an atmosphere of complexity and uncertainty. In light of the 30-year review of the ICPD and ongoing challenges to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), it's evident that evaluation must adapt and evolve to remain a driving force for transformational change.

To step up the pace, UNFPA has implemented an adaptive management model, A-Compass, that prioritizes learning and adaptation to accelerate progress. Agility and adaptation in evaluation are vital components of this approach. This vision is captured in Evaluation Policy 2024 and Evaluation Strategy 2022-2025, which focus on advancing targeted, responsive, user-oriented and adaptive evaluations to enhance decision-making based on evidence.

To take a more structured approach to adaptive evaluation, the IEO has released a new resource pack. This resource offers adaptive evaluation guidance, approaches, methods and tools to:

- Enhance evaluation use
- · Facilitate real-time learning and adaptation
- Capture complexity
- Capture UNFPA contribution in unpredictable environments
- Foster leadership roles in adaptive evaluation
- · Promote an adaptive evaluation mindset

This resource pack is part of the third phase of the developmental evaluation of resultsbased management at UNFPA, which involved supporting offices in testing methods, promoting a community of practice, and coaching early adopters of adaptive evaluation.

Given that adaptive evaluation promotes a culture of continuous learning and improvement, this innovative approach will enable stakeholders, including evaluators, to accelerate the delivery of the SDGs and ICPD.
