1- Final Evaluation of the UNSDCF 2023 - 2027	The main objective of the evaluation will be to assess quantitatively and qualitatively the contribution of the United Nations (UN) through its sustainable development framework plan (UNSDCF), on which the 9th UNFPA-CAR cooperation programme 2023-2027 will be aligned, to the achievement of national priorities contained in the National Recovery and Peacebuilding Plan (RCPCA) which will end in 2023, the new plan that will emerge from the 2050 vision that will begin after 2023 and the progress made by CAR towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). In addition, this evaluation will be an independent exercise to review the overall expected and unexpected results of UN System cooperation in CAR, which will be used to inform the design of the future UNSDCF beyond 2027.
