Evidence utilized in the design of the costed plan	An external evaluation of the Sub-regional Programme 2017-2021 has been carried out. Two evaluations were conducted in the sixth Sub-regional programme that informed the costed evaluation plan: the regional “Evaluation on Supplies and Family Planning” and the global “Evaluation of UNFPA support to gender equality and women's empowerment (2012-2020” with Latin America and Caribbean region as the regional study. Other evidence informing the costed evaluation plan includes: (a) the Reproductive Health Commodity Security Assessment of 16 countries across the Caribbean; (b) Youth Assessment relating to the comprehensive SRH/HIV/GBV needs of young women, men, girls, and boys in all their diversity and vulnerability across the English and Dutch-speaking Caribbean; (c) MISP Readiness Assessments in five countries; and (d) the SRH legislative review of the 22 English and Dutch speaking Caribbean countries
