Total Institutional Budget expenses for 2022 and 2023 (comprising development effectiveness, United Nations development coordination, management, independent oversight and assurance as well as special purpose cost categories) amounted to \$385.2 million or 13.5 per cent of the total use of resources. Of the total programme expenses, including other resources (\$2,465.2 million), \$2,193.3 million was for country programmes, \$251.1 million was for global and regional programmes and \$20.8 million was for the emergency fund. Note that the information in this table is presented on a modified accrual basis, consistent with the budget presentation, and thus it is not the same as in the main document or other tables in this annex.

# 2. Annex 2. Annual update on differentiated cost-recovery rates and approved waivers

1. In line with Executive Board decision 2020/12 (DP/FPA-ICEFUNW/2020/1) on joint comprehensive cost-recovery policy, this Annex provides information on the financial impact of the harmonized differentiated cost-recovery rates and waivers granted.

#### **Cost-recovery waivers**

2. In 2023, UNFPA continued to limit the granting of cost-recovery waivers only to exceptional cases, in order to facilitate life-saving work. A summary of the cost-recovery waivers approved in the last three years with the associated financial impact is provided in the table below:

#### Multilateral agreements with inherited reduced cost-recovery rates<sup>24</sup>

5. In 2023, United Nations system organizations (including pooled funds and interorganizational transfers) contributed \$208.2 million to UNFPA, becoming the organization's top donor to other resources for the fifth year in a row (2022: \$218.7 million). These results demonstrate UNFPA investment and readiness to advance United Nations development system reform, while continuing to prioritize joined-up mechanisms to effectively implement the common chapter with the United Nations system organizations and deliver on the Sustainable Development Goals and the 2030 Agenda.
