Every adolescent and youth, especially adolescent girls, are empowered to access sexual and reproductive health and reproductive rights, development and well-being

Young people, in particular adolescent girls, have the skills and knowledge to make informed choices about their SRH and RR, development and well-being

Policies prioritize adolescents and youth, and address the broader determinants of their sexual and reproductive health

Critical assumption

Advocacy

- Advocate for implementation of multisectoral programmes responding to SRH needs of young people, especially adolescent girls
- Advocate for the review of laws and policies that negatively affect adolescents and youth, especially girls
- Advocate for large-scale, sustainable sexuality education that is comprehensive and reaches young people both in and out of school (CSE)
- Strengthen participatory platforms that advocate for increased investments in marginalized adolescents and youth in national policies and programmes, humanitarian action and sustaining peace initiatives

Strengthened response to eliminate harmful practices, including child, early and forced marriage, Female Genital Mutilation and son preference

Improved population data systems to map and address inequalities to advance SDGs and ICPD including in humanitarian settings

Contribution from other outcome areas

Increased multi-sectoral capacity to prevent and address gender-based violence with a focus on data, health, psycho-social support, and coordination, within a continuum approach

Capacity

- Strengthen countries' capacity to develop evidence-based, comprehensive programmes targeting the furthest behind first, especially adolescent girls
- Strengthen technical capacity to improve CSE coverage and quality, with a focus on curricula, pedagogy and evaluation
- Build leadership capacities of adolescent and youth through organizations led by and serving young people, and networks of young people
- Strengthen capacities of young people to be effective humanitarian actors in preparedness, response and recovery

Knowledge

- Support research and evidence generation on sustainable and scalable approaches to reaching and serving adolescents and youth, particularly marginalized sub-groups

Partnership and coordination

- Establish partnerships with adolescent and youth-led organizations
- Convene the Compact for Young People in Humanitarian Action
- Engage in interagency collaboration and joint programming in the areas of adolescents and youth
- Partner with those stakeholders that lead the areas mentioned under the critical assumption and monitor the effectiveness of multisectoral approach
