Advocacy

- ❑ Advocate for the development of national policies, and their implementation by use of sound evidence on population and development linkages
- ❑ Advocate for the identification of demographic disparities and social and economic inequities that affect access of women, adolescents and youth to sexual and reproductive health
- ❑ Advocate for the utilization of data on demographic dividend to advocate for increased focus on empowerment of adolescents and youth, with special attention on young women and marginalized populations

Capacity

- ❑ Strengthen national capacity to generate and use population and health data from census, CRVS and HH surveys
- ❑ Generate and use sub-national and small area estimation across all data sectors
- ❑ Promote innovative tools, including Big Data, to enhance population data in settings where heightened insecurity, displacement and humanitarian crises limit traditional data
- ❑ Enhance capacity to identify those furthest behind
- ❑ Embed population trends and needs within policies, programmes and advocacy

Knowledge

- ❑ Generate evidence in population and development for knowledge sharing that supports policy formulation and program implementation
- ❑ Track donor and domestic financial resource flows for population activities
- ❑ Promote South-South and triangular cooperation and exchange of best practices

Partnership and coordination

- ❑ Work and share the division of labour with UN Statistics Division and key stakeholders to strengthen census
- ❑ Collaborate with large consortium of partners on CRVS
- ❑ Partner with those stakeholders that lead the areas mentioned under the critical assumption and monitor the effectiveness of multisectoral approach
