Note by the Executive Director

Summary

The present note contains information on the one-year extensions of the UNFPA country programmes for Afghanistan and Timor-Leste.

In accordance with established procedures, the Executive Director approves the first one-year extension of a country programme, while requests for second one-year extensions or requests for two-year extensions are submitted to the Executive Board for approval.

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the one-year country programme extensions for Afghanistan and Timor-Leste, as indicated in the attached table.
